Prayers of Thanksgiving and Intercession

Increase a spirit of generosity as the nation begins to rebuild social structures damaged in the pandemic, so that the needs of Indigenous Peoples will not be overlooked.

God, we feel sadness for those whose lives are marked by isolation and fear, by grief or despair, effects deepened by the times of physical distancing. Send your Spirit of healing and reconciliation to draw the lonely into friendships, and as society begins to reopen, create a true sense of belonging for each one. Heal any burden of grief and bring hope through your eternal friendship.

God, we are hopeful for the church because it belongs to you. Send your Spirit to guide our witness in the world. Teach us how to share our experience of your love and invite others to join the journey toward healing and reconciliation.

We ask for continued blessing and protection as our society relaxes the pandemic guidelines. We pray for help to not be careless but to continue to be careful and be concerned for everyone.

We offer this prayer by Carl Yusavitz, a chaplain at Penn Foundation. Good and gracious God, we believe that the world you created is good and that even when we face difficult times, as we do these days, we continue trusting in your providential love. During this pandemic, our minds and hearts are all over the place with concern, fear, and worry. Help us remember that, as a nation and as individuals, we have been through difficult times before and trust the lessons we learned--that we are all "in this together," we are all vulnerable, and we all need each other. We ask you to help us to find practical ways to put that faith into action, as we navigate the days and weeks ahead. Jesus, we thank you again for the many ways you have seen our church through difficult times. And we ask your help to continue to be exemplary witness and faithful followers. Amen.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we feel we are unable to deliver our summer camp program in a way that adequately protects our staff, volunteers, parents, grandparents, and campers.
