- Update on Refugee Sponsorship:

Greetings from Wildwood Mennonite Church.

I am on the Refugee Sponsorship Committee at Wildwood and thought that it would be good to give your church an update on the progress of the sponsorship of the Karen family that our churches are collaborating on. Actually, the progress is very slow and there is a lot of waiting involved. All the forms required by Immigration have been completed though, and we are waiting for the family members to have their passport photos taken in the refugee camp. They need to go to the IOM (International Organization for Migration) office in the camp to have this done. However, the IOM people are not always there - they seem to move from camp to camp which makes it difficult. So, we keep on waiting.

Fortunately, we do have a way of communicating with the family in Thailand. Mor Ae Lah, who is a nephew of the woman who is being sponsored along with her children, is in frequent contact with them and has on several occasions included me in a video call with them. Shar Wah doesn't speak English and I don't speak Karen, but Mor Ae Lah is a great translator!

So that's about all I can tell you right now about where things are at. I'm not sure how much information you have received previously about the family, but please let me know if your church would like to know more at this point.
